VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK

#1 - Akagera National Park

The relatively warm and low-lying plains of Akagera comprise savannah, woodland, wetland and a dozen lakes. In partnership with African Parks, we aim to transform the National Park into a world-class location to experience a safari.

The largely open expanse is ideal for game viewing, and we are taking steps to ensure the Big Five roam the park in greater numbers over the course of time.

#2 - LAKE KIVU

Part of Africa's Great Rift Valley, Lake Kivu in the west of Rwanda. it is surrounded by magnificent mountains and has deep emerald green waters covering a surface area of 2,700 km2. It is Rwanda's largest lake and the sixth largest in

#4 - CANOPY WALK

Suspended above a ravine in the lush montane rainforest of <u>Nyungwe National Park</u>, the canopy walkway provides an exhilarating perspective on the ancient treetops and wildlife. The 160m long and 70m high suspension bridge is accessible as part of a guided tour along the lgishigishigi trail, or to those <u>hiking</u> the Imbaraga or Umuyove trails.
